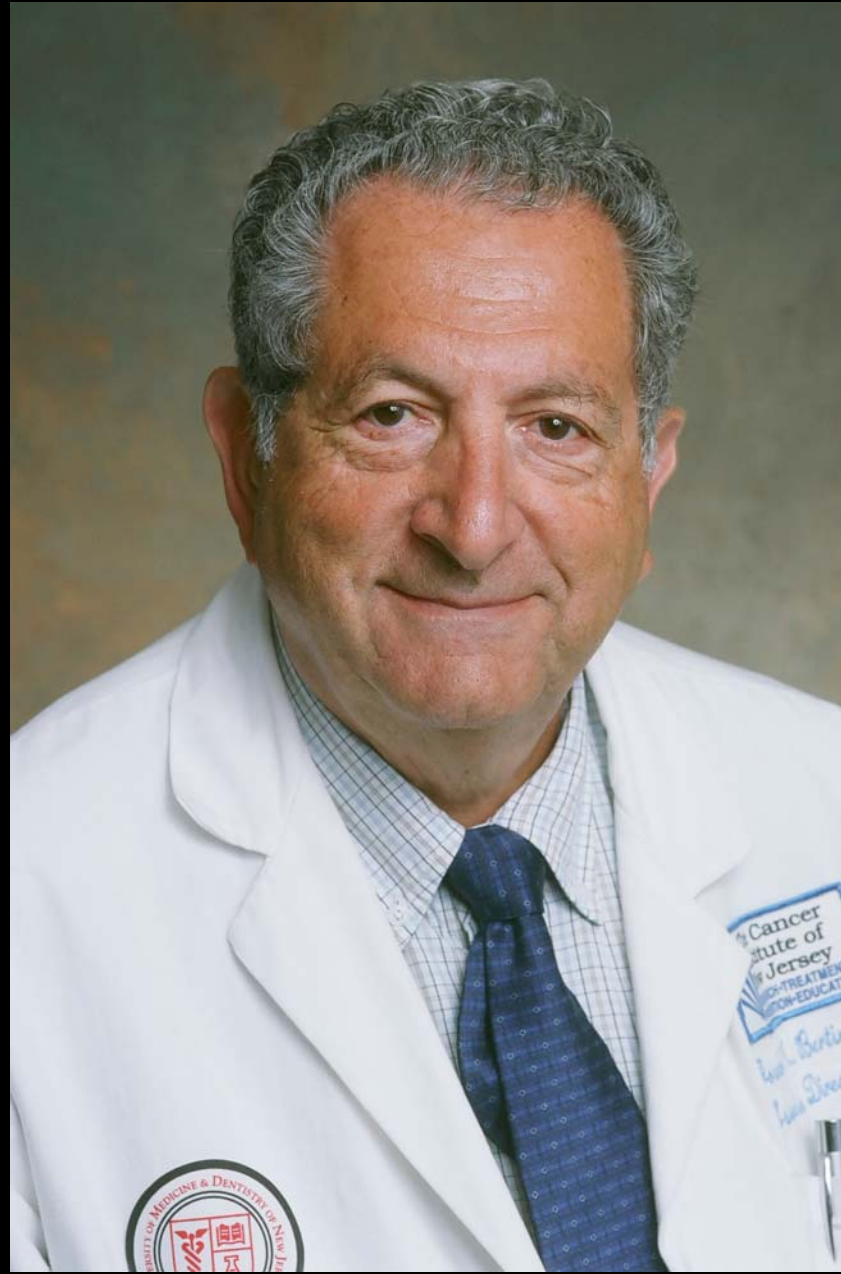


Joseph R. Bertino, MD

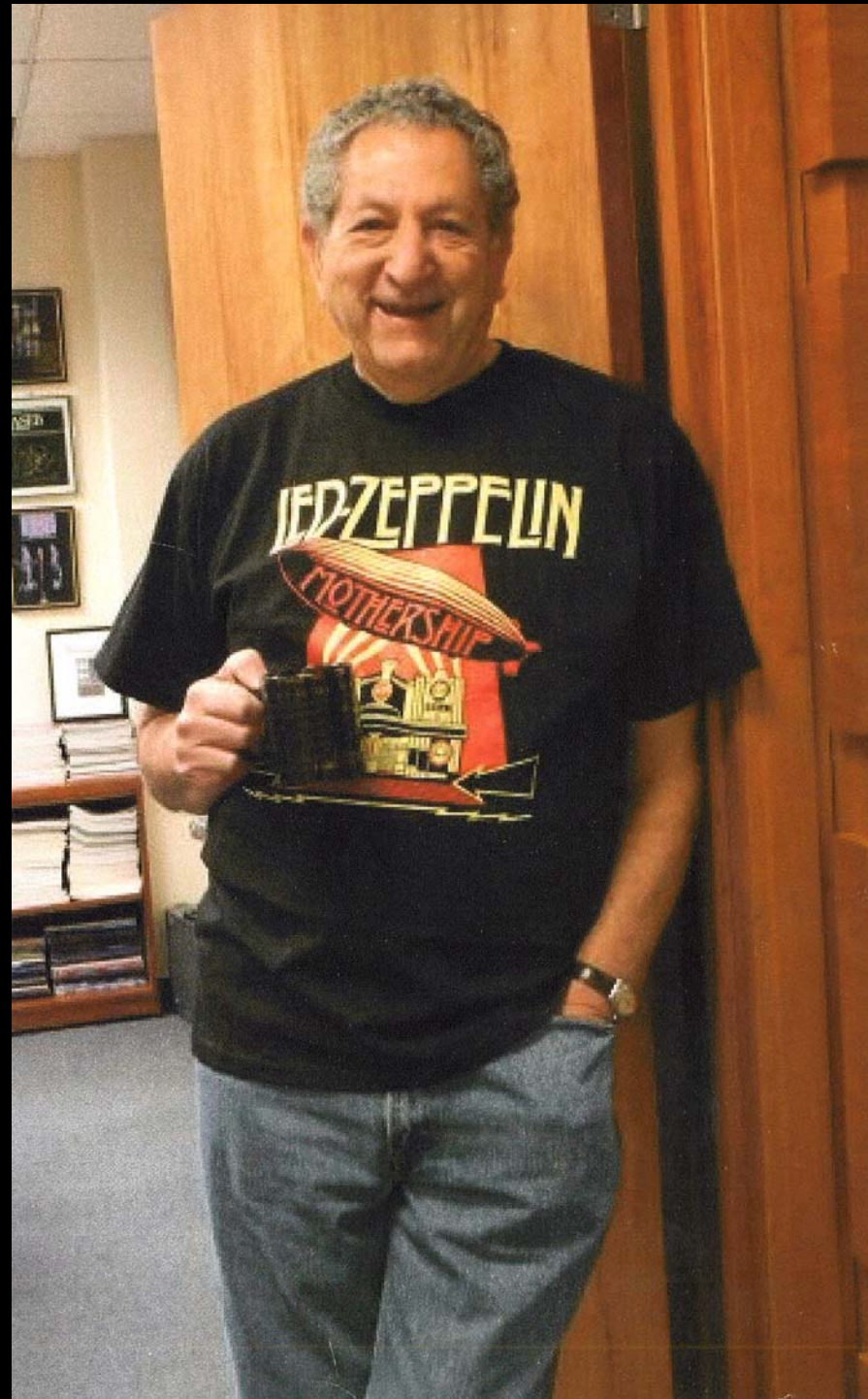
