“The advances in technology in healthcare have been enormous. The regulatory structure has not been able to keep up. Our enabling legislation from the 1950’s was designed for a prescriptive regulatory program.

We need to shift to a regulatory system that is based on quality assurance systems. Medical misadministrations show us where we need to improve. We need to come up with a better way to hold every facility accountable for maintaining quality systems which prevent errors.”
